

## PUBLIC HEALTH ACT 1936: SECTION 269 CERTIFICATE OF EXEMPTION

WHEREAS by sub-section (6) of Section 269 of the Public Health Act 1936, it is provided that if an organisation satisfies the Secretary of State that it takes reasonable steps for securing

- (a) that camping sites belonging to or provided by it, or used by its members, are properly managed and kept in good sanitary condition, and
- (b) that moveable dwellings used by its members are so used as not to give rise to any nuisance.

the Secretary of State may grant to that organisation a certificate of exemption from the provisions of said Section 269:

AND WHEREAS the **Norfolk Camping CIC,72 South Beach Road, Heacham, Norfolk** has applied to the Secretary of State for such a certificate of exemption as aforesaid and has satisfied the Secretary of State as to the matters aforesaid:

NOW THEREFORE the Secretary of State in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by the said sub-section (6) of Section 269 of the Public Health Act 1936, hereby grants the **Norfolk Camping CIC** a certificate of exemption from the provisions of the said Section 269 dated this 30<sup>th</sup> day of September 2020.
